In this term our topic is called Wellingborough a local area study.

Within this topic we will look at the surrounding area on maps, visit and photograph the surrounding area. We will find out about the history of the local area and get creative drawing maps and making buildings.

In RE the topics are called What does it mean to be a Humanist? And Spiritual Art

In PHSE the units are 'Respecting privacy' the core theme is relationships. Then 'Special days' part of living in the wider world.

The science topic for the whole term is called Living things including humans. We describe the human life cycle and look at the circulatory system and the function of the heart and blood. We investigate the impact of diet, exercise, drugs and lifestyle choices have on people.

In Computing we will be using multi-media and word to present information and also focus on e-awareness and internet safety. Children may wish to use word or power point to present some information about 'Wellingborough'.

Our PE for these terms is a unit of outdoor and adventurous games and an athletics unit called 'go for gold' in this we try athletic events. We have some multi skills sessions with the coach Juliette on Tuesday so please make sure P.E kits are at school.

We will have lots of great Numeracy and Literacy learning planned following the curriculum and we also continue to use reading eggs for English and Mathematics for Maths.

We will have homework tasks set on a Friday for the following Friday and please help by listening to your child read at home.
