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# TOPICS FOR SPRING TERM 2021

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**Literacy** - we will be learning about stories with familiar settings. We will be sharing stories such as, 'Dogger' and 'Mog' and will retell and perform stories as a class as well as exploring story props, such as animals and school objects. We also will learn about recounts in a form of memories book and get to know some information books about food chains.

**Numeracy** - In maths, we will have lots of fun learning about counting and number before beginning learning about addition and subtraction. We will also be learning about measure which this term will include money, we will learn through practical experiences in role play. Later in the term we will be learning about properties of shape and will look at 2D and 3D shapes linked to our work in the thematic curriculum.

**Topic** - Our theme this term is 'Do you remember being small?' and we will be describing all ourselves, our emotions and memories to understand what kind of experience they bring, also how do they help us in life. We begin our learning by focusing on ourselves in general and then our families. We will link above theme to science week which is animals, their young and their habitats and will use different approaches to make experience richer including art, technology, cooking, physical exercise and many other ways.

**RE** - Our theme in RE is 'Where is God' and we will be learning all about what are beliefs and traditions for all religions.

**PE** - We will be continuing our activities to ensure that our bodies stay fit through manipulating, writing as well as sensory circuit activities and outside play activity.
